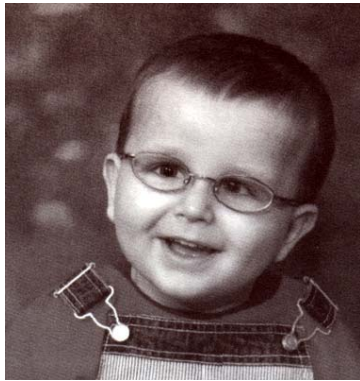


Grants Available to Families with Children with Cancer

2009-2010 Grant Guidelines



Help for families in need who have children undergoing cancer treatments.

Introduction

The Community Foundation for the Twin Tiers (CFTT) is a public charity whose mission is to continuously improve the present and future quality of life in the counties served by the foundation.

This brochure is designed to answer questions on the types of costs we will consider for funding under the Jordan Wilcox Endowment Fund for 2009.

Who May Apply for Funds

Any family that has a child undergoing treatment for cancer may apply or any eligible non-profit organization that serves families with children with cancer.

What We Will Support

These grant funds are to cover costs of care not covered by health insurance, i.e., travel costs, housing while child is undergoing treatment, meals while away from home for treatments, etc.

The conditions for receiving these grant funds are: 1.) verification of the expenditure of funds by the family or an invoice for expenses for which payment is being sought, and 2.) proof these expenditures were not previously covered by health insurance. Proper documentation must be presented before any check will be issued.

How Much We Award

The amount of the award will be decided by the CFTT Board of Directors who will take many factors into consideration including family circumstances. Any non-profit organization applying for a grant must be an eligible recipient under IRS guidelines. Please call if you need clarification on this issue.

Applying For Funds

If you are a family who has a child undergoing treatment for cancer and would like to apply for these funds please call the CFTT to begin this process.

If you are a non-profit organization that is offering services to these families then we would be happy to work with or through you to distribute these grant funds to eligible families. From families we will need the following information:

- Their name, address, contact information
- An invoice for expenses to be paid
- If payment is to be a reimbursement for expenses already paid then we will need copies of receipts for these expenses and proof they weren't already paid by insurance

In addition, if an organization, we will need proof of your non-profit status.

Deadline for Submittals

*The grant(s) will be awarded as families are identified. **Submissions can be made at any time.** All applications will be reviewed by a CFTT Advisory Board who will recommend grant recipient(s) to the Board of Directors.
