- Preference will be given to students pursuing a degree in one of the following: Electrical Engineering, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Software Engineering, Data Analytics, Cyber Security.
- Applicants must provide a resume and a 500-word essay on why they chose to pursue this particular degree, and how they will use their education to improve their community/society.
- Please provide a list of school-based activities (including leadership positions, clubs, and athletics) as well as community volunteer activities, and the number of months or years.
