

Nanette Good Music Education Scholarship

The Nanette Good Music Education Scholarship honors the life and legacy of Nanette H. Good, a dedicated educator, lifelong musician, and committed community leader.

Nanette was a graduate of Wyalusing Valley High School (Class of 1968) and Mansfield State Teachers College, where she earned a Master's Degree in Education. She taught elementary school in Sullivan County and the Troy area, and she also taught music to third- and fourth-grade students, sharing her love of learning and the arts with generations of children.



A gifted pianist and organist, Nanette served as the organist at St. John's Lutheran Church for over 50 years. She was a founding board member of the Bradford County Regional Arts Council and remained deeply involved in community service throughout her life.

This scholarship supports students pursuing a degree in education, with preference given to those with an interest in music, reflecting Nanette's lifelong dedication to teaching, service, and the transformative power of music.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a graduating senior and resident of Bradford or Sullivan County, PA.
- Must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited technical school, university, or college in the United States.
- Must be pursuing a degree in education, with a preference in music education.
- Write an essay (200-250 words, double-spaced). Why have you chosen to pursue a degree in education, and what motivates you to become an educator? If you plan to pursue a degree in music education, how has music influenced your decision to choose this field of study?
- Please provide a list of school-based activities (including leadership positions, clubs, and athletics) as well as community volunteer activities, and the number of months or years.
