Call for Nominations

Nomination Guidelines

This \$500 award is intended for the recipient to make a grant to the nonprofit organization of their choice.

Eligibility:

Individuals may nominate themselves.

Nominators must be individuals not organizations, though an individual may nominate a colleague within their organization/place of employment.

Characteristics of Award Recipients

Given the award is intended for individuals, who share Bill Ransom's vision and commitment, through service to the Valley community of Waverly, Sayre and/or Athens, the winner will have demonstrated the following characteristics:

Provides leadership & vision
Has been a mentor & role model to others
Time devoted to improve the community has been significant
Is pro-active and has produced positive change

Helpful Tips:

For your nomination to stand out against the many others we receive, providing a clear explanation and including evidence and clear examples of what makes your nominee so exceptional will strengthen your nomination.

Remember we may not know your nominee or what makes them special so it's important to use specific and concrete examples to illustrate how your nominee meets the eligibility and selection criteria. A compelling nomination should also describe as vividly and precisely as possible the difference your nominee's contribution has made.

Deadlines and Notifications:

Nominations must be submitted by 5:00 pm on Thursday, September 5, 2019. The award will be presented publicly at a ceremony on Thursday, September 19, 2019 from 6:00-8:00 at the Rail House Restaurant and Tap Room, 366 Broad Street, Waverly, NY.
