- Pursuing a degree at an accredited two or four-year university, college, or technical school in the United States.
- Demonstrate a good work ethic, be of good character and understand community service through volunteerism.
- Must have earned at least a 75-grade point average while in high school. Attach a copy of high school transcript.
- Please attach a short, computer-generated essay (200–250 words double spaced) about what life lessons you have learned when taking care of your animals. How have they made you who you are today? How will this help your future?
