

Shang Family Scholarship Application

David and Renate Shang were transplants to Tioga County but spent the majority of their lifetime living and raising their family in the Owego/Apalachin area.

When David C.T. Shang immigrated to the United States from Taiwan in 1950, he was already a passionate, lifelong student in the tradition of a classical Chinese scholar - a product of a culture that for thousands of years placed emphasis on success through academic learning and study. He quickly came to love America and, while a poor student living in New York City in the late 1950s, he met and married his other lifelong love, a German immigrant named Renate Albrecht. Together they struggled to make a living, with David taking classes during the day, and studying during quiet moments while working at night. Finally, he earned a Master of Science in Chemistry after writing his thesis using data from a spectrophotometer he built out of an old refrigerator. This advanced scientific training, and his innate creativity allowed him to successfully enter the world of applied engineering, resulting in an eventual move to Owego, NY in 1964 after accepting a position with IBM.

David was a continuous learner whose intellectual curiosity was never satiated. Despite his full-time employment and busy family life, he always loved to read, learn, listen to classical music, and cultivate his mind. This drive for academic excellence was emphasized as he and Renate raised their sons in the Owego-Apalachin School system, with the boys graduating from Owego Free Academy in 1979, 1981, and 1984 and all three subsequently graduating from Duke University's Pratt School of Engineering. Through their dedication and devotion, one son is a successful anesthesiologist, another a patent attorney/product manager and the third son has retired from a successful engineer career.

David and Renate believed Tioga County was the perfect place to raise their children, with its combination of the intellectual base provided by IBM set in the idyllic rural setting of the Susquehanna River Valley. David and Renate always cherished their time in Owego and credited it with helping foster the success of their sons, whether it was extracurricular school and sports activities, Boy Scout Troop 53, or summer camp at Camp Truman. They instilled a commitment to service in their sons, encouraging them to volunteer at Robert Packer Hospital. It was their sincere wish that the Shang family give back to the community that nurtured them. In addition to gifts to Owego United Methodist Church and the Owego Boy's Club, the David & Renate Shang Scholarship was created.

- Please attach a short essay (200–250 words double spaced) of what makes you an excellent candidate to pursue a degree in engineering, mathematics, or science and why you are passionate about it.
